It doesn't matter where you are.

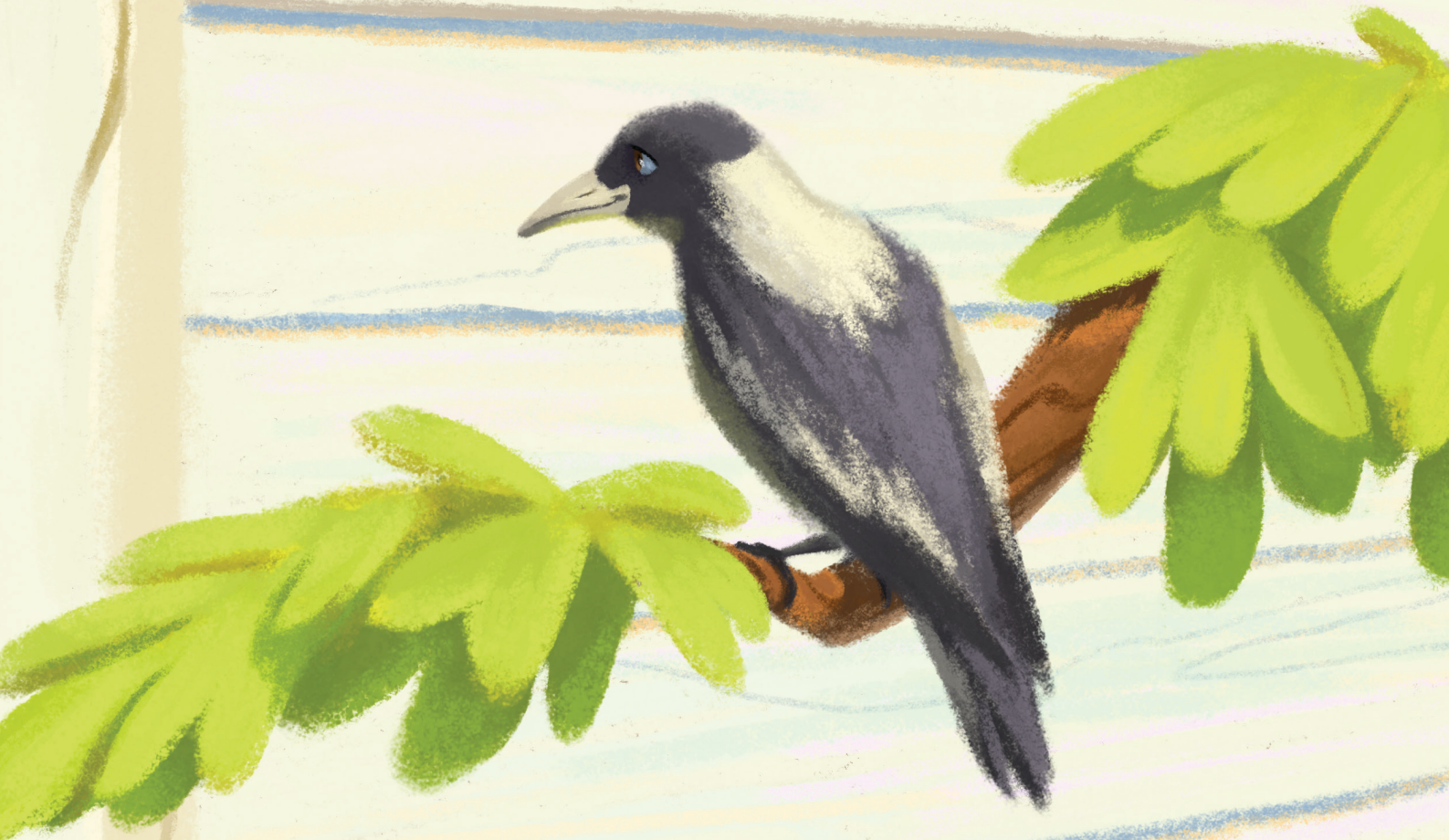


On your own...
